USE OF PONTOON

CRUISER OWNERS:

Please be reminded that this pontoon is provided for use by members for short term periods only – for loading and unloading, general repairs and maintenance.

Short term means periods between tides up to a maximum of around 24hrs or so.

Please contact the Hon. Cruiser Secretary if you wish to stay for longer periods.

SAFETY BOAT CREWS:

Unless instructed otherwise by your PRO or an officer of the club, please return the safety/committee boats to their moorings after a race. Their moorings are the best place for them, both from a security point of view and for maximum time afloat.

GENERAL:

Remember, the Pontoon is a shared resource!

- (1) Moor considerately to maximise available space
- (2) Small boats to use the INSIDE of the pontoon if possible
- (3) Owners should be prepared to move their boats to assist others in coming alongside and to raft their boats if necessary
- (4) Please look at the club programme and be aware there will be times when the pontoon is in heavy demand, so arrange your visits accordingly
- (5) DO NOT FORGET – The other, brand new pontoon is also available and shallower draft craft that can use it should try and do so.
