

Dinghy Park Information

Members who apply to the Membership Secretary for a space in the Dinghy Park are referred to the Dinghy Park Ranger who will then allocate a slot according to the class/size of their boat. Once a dinghy has been allocated a slot, a coloured TAG will be fixed to the launch trolley showing the allocated slot on one side and the owners name on the other (the colour of the TAG is changed each year). Do not use any other slot to that allocated. There are nine rows of slots A – H (incl) plus T specifically for Teras.

You are responsible for keeping your slot tidy with the grass cut short and weeds in gravel areas regularly removed. Please do not use trimmers as the shards can damage adjacent boats.

If you also own a road trailer and wish to leave it in the Dinghy Park it must be CLEARLY MARKED with your name and stowed at the bottom end of the Dinghy Park on the marshland.

If your dinghy is in the Dinghy Park awaiting slot allocation please clearly mark it with your name.

If you change your dinghy or sell it to someone else, please inform the Dinghy Park Ranger.

Any unidentified dinghies in the Dinghy Park will be removed to the "Sin Bin" to await disposal.

Members wishing to keep a Tender in the Dinghy Park should first contact the Cruiser Secretary.
